Village of Hewlett Neck Plumbing Inspection Requirements

Effective: March 29, 2013

- 1) All inspections are required to meet New York State Building Code. The New York State Building Code is updated every 3 years and all inspections are subject to the latest printed version.*
- 2) The licensed plumber must be on site for all inspections. Proper identification is required (i.e.: driver's license). It is strongly recommended to call with any questions or concerns prior to commencing or completing any work if it relates to New York State Building Code compliance.*
- 3) Please provide permit number and address of permit location when scheduling inspections. 24 Hour notice for all inspections is required. Please call (516)766-7684. Please provide adequate lighting and a clean environment during all inspections.*
- 4) Gas pressure test must be @4 psi for a minimum of 20 minutes.*
- 5) Structural beams cut to accommodate plumbing work may delay plumbing inspection progress or approval. Building inspector must review all structural modifications not recognized by New York State Building Code and /or manufacturer's specifications.*
