

REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT OF FUEL TANKS

Jurisdiction of Nassau County Department of Health -
All tanks other than gasoline, diesel or kerosene

Village will require -

- Application for Village permit - Information to include:

Name & address of homeowner
Name & address of contractor
Size of tank
Material used to fill tank*
What will be replacing tank

- Copy of letter of affirmation to N.C. Dept. of Health from homeowner that tank is non-leaking.
- Copy of contractor's general liability (Village to be named additional insured) and workers compensation insurance certificates

- Notification of date work is scheduled so that arrangements can be made for plumbing inspector to be on site.
- If tank is known to be leaking or in excess of 1,000 gallons, a copy of the soil test report is needed.
- Completion of affidavit for issuance of Certificate of Completion when work is done.

*AS PER N.C. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH - ALL TANKS SOUTH OF SUNRISE HIGHWAY MUST BE FILLED WITH SAND OR CONCRETE AND CANNOT BE FILLED WITH FOAM.
